Handbook Reminder: VISITS AND CALLS

No teacher is to be disturbed during class or immediately before a class period. Teachers will be available for parent needs outside of class hours. Business of any nature between a parent and teacher should not be taken care of in school hallways or classrooms when students are present. **Appointments should be made in advance.**

Important Information from the Office

- ★ Please don't forget to call the attendance line **every day** your child is either absent or tardy.
- ★ Return your Tuesday Family (plastic) envelope to the school office. You may need to check with your child if he or she returned it. Often they are found in a desk, backpack or locker!
- ★ Remember notify the school office with any changes that would affect our ability to contact you. This includes home, work or cell-phone numbers. Also, the office needs to be aware of changes in employment and parish affiliation.
