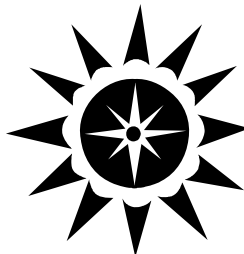

Safe Guarding All God's Family Training – April 7th

In 2002, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops approved the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*. One of the mandates of the *Charter* is that every diocese, parish and Catholic institution implement a "safe-environment policy" to ensure that children and young people are not put at risk for sexual abuse. In compliance with that mandate, the Archdiocese of Milwaukee implemented ***Safeguarding All of God's Family***, which will ensure that every parish and institution in the Archdiocese is also in full compliance with the *Charter's* mandate.

Under the provision of this policy, all paid parish employees, all paid school employees, and all parish and school volunteers who have regular contact with children are required to participate in ***Safeguarding All of God's Family*** in order to continue to serve in these capacities.

If you are a volunteer in our schools and have not yet received the Safe Guarding All God's Family training, we ask that you PLEASE attend one of the training sessions being held within the Archdiocese. **A session is being held at St. Mary's on Monday, April 7th at 6:00 p.m. in the Community Room.** Please see the flyer attached with directions on how to register for this or any of the other sessions.

Uniform Reminders

- Students will be asked to tuck in shirts when going to Mass.

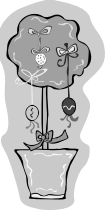

Holy Week

The Parting of the Red Sea – “The God Leads Me” Miracle *Read Exodus 14*

Our bible story this week is about Moses leading God's people away from their cruel captors in Egypt. They were told to prepare a “Passover meal” and mark their houses with the “blood of a spotless lamb,” so they would be saved from the angel of death. Moses helped his people escape and hurry to the Red Sea, where God held back the water so they could pass through on a dry path. Jesus and his disciples remembered that very event during Holy Week with a Passover meal. Like Moses, Jesus leads us every day, protecting and loving us, and leads us right through death until we reach our heavenly home. He is our Passover Lamb, our “spotless Lamb.”

Market Day

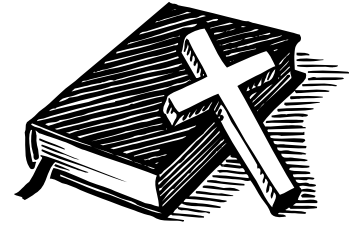
The next Market Day orders are due to school by Wednesday, April 2nd, and on-line by Saturday, April 5th.
