Jr. Crusader Baseball

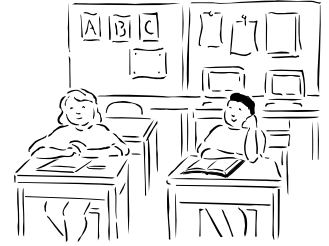

Last week students earned a total of \$359.50 for the Zickau family. The contribution of \$.25 per student was made each day if students didn't receive code of conducts for last week.

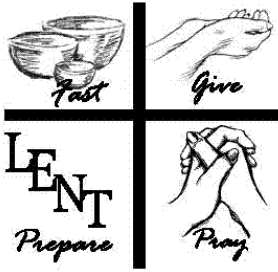
