On April 8th the School District of Waukesha's Board passed the Waukesha Community Collaboration for Four-Year Olds. The initiative will provide education for 4 year olds by partnering with existing childcare providers and preschools.

After receiving this news, Mrs. Kovaleski, Mr. Radomski, and Mrs. Caruso met to make our decision regarding our participation for next year. We have decided not to participate for the 2009-2010 school year. We continue to have many unanswered questions and feel the timeline is too fast for us to make quality programming decisions, especially in regards to how we would fulfill state requirements and teach religion which is central to our mission.

We will continue to explore the option for the 2010-2011 school year. We plan to visit Catholic schools that are participating in similar district partnerships to see and hear the pros and cons of their involvement.
