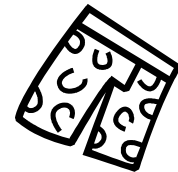
## NEED TO KNOW

Decisions will be made with the students best interests in mind. If there is any significant need that the parent feels must be addressed, it must be made known to the principal in writing. The decision of the principal is final.*

Please note that I feel the teachers at St. Mary's are dedicated individuals who have the best interest of each and every child in mind. Their judgment is important in student placement. Placement requests will only be considered if the rationale is justified. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
