Dear Parents of St. William Campus:

The strategy of the CDC and the Waukesha Public Health Department regarding how schools deal with the H1N1 (Swine) influenza has changed. This change forces individuals to take responsibility for the public health issues that affect everyone. If your child is ill, keep him/her home from school.

During the last several days, we have been in contact with authorities from the Waukesha Public Health Department and they are continuing to provide guidelines for students who have been tested for the H1N1 influenza. It is my understanding that a child who has been tested must stay home from school until the test is confirmed as negative or until seven days after the first symptoms appeared. **In the case of the child in Kindergarten at SWC, the test results were negative.**

We will continue to share information as it affects St. William Campus in as timely a manner as we are able.
