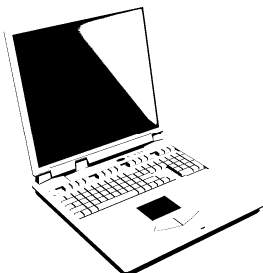


Volleyball Camp

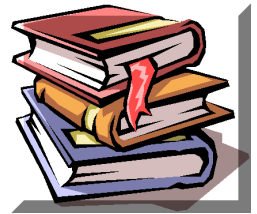
