### Official Public Health Bulletin: Interim Swine Flu Information For Schools

Waukesha Catholic has received the following information from the Waukesha County Public Health Division:

- There are 6 probable cases in Waukesha County.
- There are 4 schools that are closed.
- If your school is not closed, it is ok to attend. Ultimately, it is the parent's decision to send their child.
- Prevention:
  - If you are sick, do not come to school or work
  - Use proper etiquette when coughing or sneezing
  - Avoid sick people
- If you are sick, CALL your doctor rather than urgent or emergency care; avoid waiting in a waiting room.

## Official Public Health Bulletin: Interim Swine Flu Information For Schools

St. William Campus has received the following information from the Waukesha County Public Health Division:

- Swine Flu has not been identified in Waukesha County or the State of Wisconsin.
- At this time, Waukesha County Public Health Division has advised that students can continue to come to school, as long as the student is not ill.
- If the student is ill with fever over 100 degrees, has a cough, runny nose or sore throat, they should see a doctor.
- If the student is ill with the above symptoms and has traveled to Mexico within the last seven (7) days, the student should see a physician as soon as possible. The student should stay out of school until a diagnosis is made and the student is recovered.
