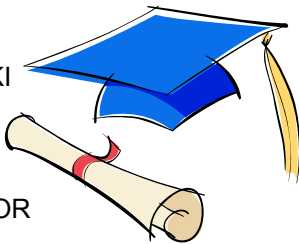

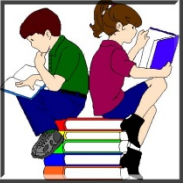
Six Flags Reading Program
