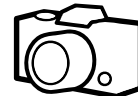
Waukesha Catholic Grandparents' Day Events

Resale Shop

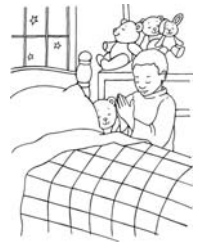
