H1N1 – Prevention Tips

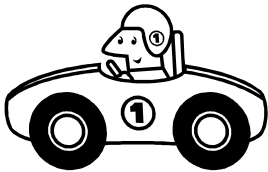
The major message being sent from the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and all the Health Departments is that prevention is key for the H1N1 flu:

1. Wash hands or use alcohol based cleaners
2. Cover coughs properly
3. Practice regular and routine cleaning
4. Stay home if experiencing flu like symptoms. Most importantly stay home until 24 hours after there is no longer a fever, without the use of fever-reducing medicines.

The symptoms of H1N1 are similar to seasonal flu. Everyone is encouraged to receive their regular seasonal flu shot.
