The Culver's Night will be Tuesday, September 27th from 5-8:00 p.m. at the Sunset location. Use your Scrip Culver's cards this evening!

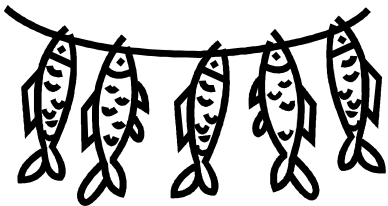
Accreditation Visit Next Week

A team of 14 will be visiting the three campus locations on Oct. 4th, 5th and 6th. They will be observing, interviewing and reviewing files and information.



This is the site visit by the Archdiocese and peers from other schools. They review our processes and procedures. This is part of a seven year evaluation cycle. The standards that we are required to maintain go beyond the Wisconsin State School requirements and include Catholic Identity and high accountability in academics. The system has been preparing documents, documentation and artifacts for an entire year. 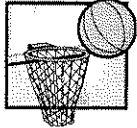

Attention 8th Grade Girls

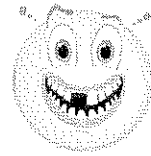


The Waukesha Catholic Athletic Department is still looking for a few more 8th grade players to participate in the 2011-2012 basketball season.

8th Grade Volunteer Opportunity

My name is Dr. Stacie Piacsek and I am a dentist. (I have four sons attending WC.) I will be donating my dental services at St. Joseph's Medical and Dental clinic on the second and fourth Tuesdays of each month (starting in October) throughout the school year. I will be there from 3:30-5 pm. I am looking for 4-8 8th graders that could assist me in a clerical manner. This means they would escort patients, check health histories for completeness, chat with waiting patients and loosely (very simply) translate for me in Spanish (if necessary). The students would NOT be assisting chair side for safety and liability reasons. The prospective volunteers should be responsible, friendly and possibly interested in the health field. They would come to the clinic directly after school and stay until they were collected at 5pm. Future sports practices/ other outside activities may conflict but I can add and omit students, as needed, throughout their eighth grade year. Two students per Tuesday would be scheduled and the schedule would be handed out once the volunteers were chosen.
