## **Success at Future Cities Competition**

The Future Cities Competition is a national project-based learning experience where students in 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade imagine, design, and build cities of the future. Students work as a team with an educator and engineer mentor to plan cities using SimCity4 Deluxe software; research and write solutions to an engineering problem; build tabletop scale models with recycled materials; and present their ideas before judges at Regional Competitions in January. Regional winners represent their region at the National Finals in Washington, DC in February.

MSOE hosted the Future Cities competition on Saturday, January 21<sup>st</sup>. Waukesha Catholic Middle School had two teams entered in the competition, a 6<sup>th</sup> grade team and a 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade team.

The 6<sup>th</sup> grade team took the Best Transportation System Award for their model city and the 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade team took the Exemplary Model award. Mr. Dave Kabara, 7<sup>th</sup> teacher, was the educator working with the teams and



Mr. Ken Nelton was the engineering mentor. The 6<sup>th</sup> grade team was composed of Sam Kramer, Mia Cornale, Jake Hallett, Stefan Klohn, Matthew Hallett, Michael Ginn, Lance Berg, Jacob Holt and Ben Chrisien. The 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade team was composed of Ben Roubik, Laura Furrer, Miranda Fritz, Matthew Wilson, Evan Cook, Alycia Hutchins, Matthew Cornale, Ryan Knuese, Alex Nelton, and Eli Usher.

### St. Joe's Winter Social

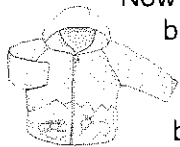
The theme "Snowball" was perfect for our social last Friday night! Despite the winter weather, students who attended had lots of fun dancing and snacking on winter themed treats.

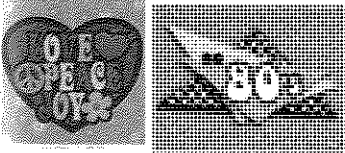

Dear Parent/Guardian:

This week we begin registering our current students for our next school year. The cost of education continues to rise but it is my hope after studying all the facts that you will see how affordable Waukesha Catholic remains.

Facts based on **this year's budget**:

- It cost Waukesha Catholic \$5,300 to educate a student.
- Tuition per student was \$2,950 – that's \$2,350 below the actual cost.
- Your parish is giving Waukesha Catholic \$1,850 per student – that can truly be considered a scholarship!
- Waukesha Catholic is raising \$500 per student to cover what is commonly known as the gap. This is another scholarship for each student!
- Based on this year's tuition for one student, it is costing you \$16.39 per day.

As you can see, Waukesha Catholic is a good value for your dollar.

Included in your packet is a **FINANCIAL INFORMATION SHEET, which lists registration fees, your family tuition and payment options.**

Dear Catholic School Parents,



Queridos Padres de Familias de nuestras Escuelas Católicas:


