The notice sent in last week's family packet regarding the Waukesha West High School Freshman orientation stated our student's orientation is on February 1st at 1:15 PM.

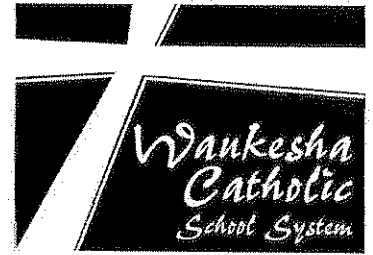
