The Culver's Night will be Tuesday, September 27th from 5-8:00 p.m. at the Sunset location. Use your Scrip Culver's cards this evening!

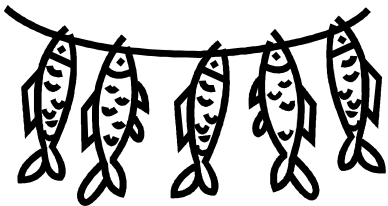
Accreditation Visit Next Week

A team of 14 will be visiting the three campus locations on Oct. 4th, 5th and 6th. They will be observing, interviewing and reviewing files and information.



This is the site visit by the Archdiocese and peers from other schools. They review our processes and procedures. This is part of a seven year evaluation cycle. The standards that we are required to maintain go beyond the Wisconsin State School requirements and include Catholic Identity and high accountability in academics. The system has been preparing documents, documentation and artifacts for an entire year. We thank teachers and parents who have taken an active role in this planning and those who will take part in the interview process.
