

## Dear Families,

Tickets are valid for students in grades K-6 only and are not valid for anyone over the age of 13. No exceptions. Each ticket is valid for one free admission only. Tickets are not for resale and are nontransferable. They cannot be replaced if lost, stolen or damaged.

Each *Read to Succeed* ticket will come with a discounted admission ticket offer for families so that they can celebrate their child's accomplishment.
