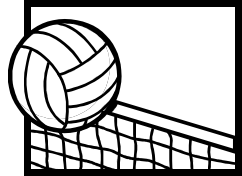

- ✘ Just a reminder to check and make sure your athlete is current with their physical. No student will be allowed to participate without a physical.



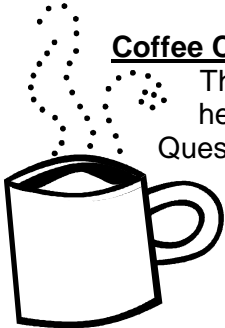
Report Cards

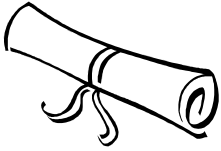
